Introduction and Clinic History

For over three quarters of a century, The Hoxsey Therapy has been used to treat serious and life threatening illnesses, including cancer. The Hoxsey Therapy originated in the United States where it had a remarkably successful intervention. In 1963, Mildred Nelson, RN, who worked with Harry Hoxsey starting in 1946 at the Hoxsey Clinic in Dallas, Texas and who he chose as his successor, founded the Bio Medical Center in Tijuana, Mexico, less than a mile from the U.S./Mexico border near San Diego, California.

Since then Bio Medical Center has been the exclusive, international home of The Hoxsey Therapy. Over the years, Mildred Nelson treated many thousands of patients, expanded and modernized the Bio Medical Center, hired and trained a staff of fully licensed English-speaking MD's and professional support personnel who take care of the medical needs of patients who visit Bio Medical Center from the United States, Canada, and all over the world.

The treatments available at the Bio Medical Center include The Hoxsey Therapy which consists of natural herbs, a specific diet, vitamins and minerals, lifestyle counselling, a positive attitude, and other innovative nontoxic or complementary alternative therapies. Modern diagnostic methods and conventional medical therapies are available when indicated at this fully accredited and licensed facility. Extensive clinical experience has shown that the treatments at the Bio Medical Center, including The Hoxsey Therapy help by working to strengthen a sick person's immune system, By rebalancing and normalizing a patient's metabolism. The therapies at the Bio Medical Center give the body a chance to heal itself, often without resorting to more toxic, debilitating treatments.

While it should be kept in mind that each patient's illness, prognosis, and outcome are different, and that no hospital or clinic can guarantee a 100 percent chance of recovery, there is evidence that many patients, some of them arriving with late stages of disease, have been helped, and their diseases brought under control. by the treatments available at the Bio Medical Center.

Before her death in January 1999, Mildred Nelson appointed her younger sister, Liz Jonas, who worked closely with Mildred at the Bio Medical Center for a number of years, as the administrator of the clinic.

Cost of Hoxsey Treatment:

Market Price for 6 months supply of tonic each time you receive it for as long as you are on the tonic. The market price is subject to change at any time. Currently (March 2012) the market price for a 6 months supply of tonic is \$800.

OTHER TREATMENT COSTS:

The charges for laboratory, X-rays and physical examination, vary from \$400 to \$900.

Additional supplements may be prescribed and they can run from \$500 to \$1,000 which brings total other costs to a range of \$900 to \$1,900, plus the tonic cost.

(These charges are to be paid in full on the day of service),

Admittance and Examination:

1. Excepting public holidays, the clinic is open Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. PST (Pacific Standard Time)
2. No appointment is necessary, however to be accepted...
3. **ALL** patients **MUST** arrive at the Bio Medical Center and check in before **9:00 am**, in order to be ready for tests and physical examination.
4. Be sure to fast on the day of your visit. Once examination and tests are completed, meals are available at the clinic.
5. The examination and personalised treatment plan are usually finished in one day, however, the patient should be prepared to stay in the area overnight and return to the clinic the next day, if necessary.
6. Patients receiving daily external treatments/dressings may be asked to stay longer (7 to 10 days) on their first visit, otherwise...
7. Make return flight reservations for late in the evening of the second day.

Directions for Driving Directly to the Clinic:

GETTING TO THE CLINIC

Current passport is necessary when crossing the border from Mexico into U.S. and it will be mandatory after January 2007

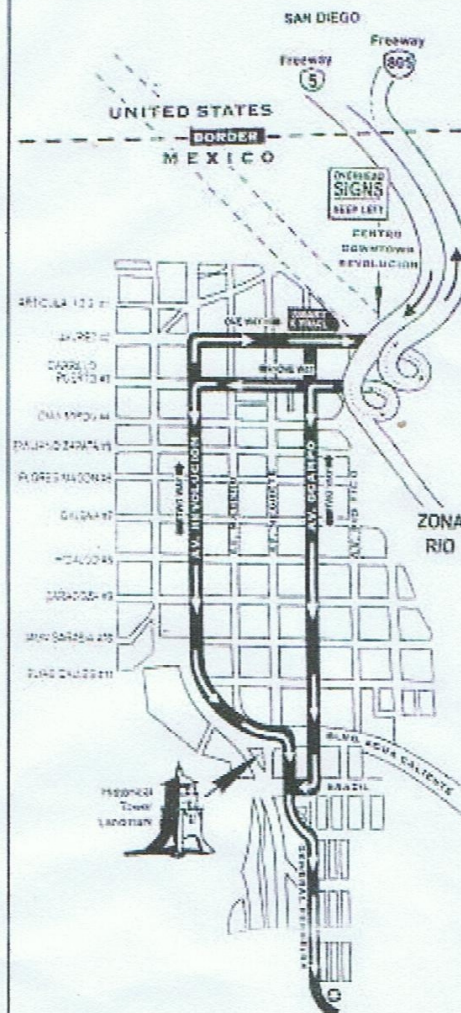
DRIVING BY CAR

Driving South from California to the Mexican border; Get in the far left lane as soon as you cross the border into Mexico. The signs will say "AV. REVOLUTION" and then "CENTRO DOWNTOWN". Stay in the far left lane and make a complete loop around and back under the highway. As soon as you complete the loop and it starts to straighten out, immediately get in the far left lane again. There will be merging traffic on your left and you only go one block to the 1st. street light. At the first street light, turn left on OCAMPO street. Stay on Ocampo *Approx. 10 blks.) and watch traffic. There is a STOP SIGN AT EVERY INTERSECTION, and they are not always visible. You will eventually GO THROUGH 4 STREET LIGHTS. After the LAST STREET LIGHT there will be a STOP sign, TURN RIGHT at the stop sign on BRASIL STREET (there may not be a street sign). Go one block to the first street and turn left on GENERAL FERREIRA and up the hill approx. 5 blocks. As you start up the steepest part of the hill, the Clinic is a two-story building on your left. It is white with large brass framed windows. Turn into the drive, and you can drop the patient at the front door. You will have to park you car on the street outside the Clinic.

NOTE: (If you miss the turn at Ocampo Street, go to the next street and turn right and then right again at the next street then right onto Ocampo).

Always drive carefully and cautiously in Mexico.
